

STAY AT HOME Expired on April 30th at 5 p.m.	AMENDED SAFER AT HOME	The Safer at Home order extends until December 11th at 5 p.m.
 STAY AT HOME ORDER: INDIVIDUALS Ordered to stay at home except to meet basic needs EMPLOYERS Businesses closed except for those that meet a critical need or pose a minimal risk; sanitation and social-distancing rules and guidelines for remaining businesses REAL STORES Essential retail stores open subject to 50% occupancy rate, social-distancing and sanitation rules Basinesses of an an antitation rules and guidelines for remaining businesses REACHES Closed for all purposes MEDICAL PROCEDURES Distored except for those deemed "necessary" under various criteria as determined Non-WORK GATHERINGS Limited to fewer than 10 persons with 6 feet of distance between persons. "Drive-in" gatherings permitted if participants stay in cars with people from their own households. SENOR CHIZEN CENTERS Regular programming suspended except meals available through curbside pick-up or delivery DEUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS Close to in-person instruction (except for daytime special activities programs) CHILD DAY CARE FACILITES Must not allow 12 or more children in a room HOSPITALS AND NURSING HOMES Must implement policies to restrict visitation RETAURANTS, BARS AND BREWENES Limited to take-out, curbside or delivery Destruction (such as night clubs, theaters, bowling alleys) Athlet facilities and activities (such as barber shops, hair salons, nail salons, tattoo services)
